Back in my military days, I had one of those classic airport moments. I was flying home for Christmas and had to connect in Minneapolis. Of course, my first flight was late—because what flight isn’t late when you’re trying to get home for Christmas, right?

So the plane lands, the door opens, and I take off running. And friends, back then, I was in shape! Now, let me be clear—this body has always been designed more to run through things than run around them, but I was moving. I’m talking weaving through the crowd like a running back trying not to get tackled, checking gate signs as I sprinted. I had just minutes to make it across that airport.

And then—it happened. I turned the corner and saw the airline employee closing the door. You know that slow-motion moment in the movies? That was me. “Nooooo!” I reached the counter breathless and begged, “Please, I’m a soldier trying to get home for Christmas!” But all she said was, “You were one minute too late.” Ouch. One minute was the difference between being home for Christmas or not.

Now thankfully, I still made it home, just a little later. But that moment has stayed with me. Because it taught me something powerful: one more matters. One more minute was all I needed.

Think about it. If your car has three good tires but one flat—guess what? You're not going anywhere. If you're one dollar short of a ten-dollar bill, you can't make the purchase. If you need a 90 to get an A in the class, but you're sitting at an 89, suddenly that one percent is the most important thing in your life.

And God feels the same way about people. About you. About me. About the world. One more soul matters.

The Bible says it this way in 2 Peter 3:9:

“The Lord isn't really being slow about his promise, as some people think. No, he is being patient for your sake. He does not want anyone to be destroyed but wants everyone to repent.”

Did you catch that? God is literally holding back the return of Jesus—because He's waiting for one more. One more person to turn to Him. One more to call Jesus Lord. One more to find eternal life.

This mission provides much-needed vehicles and equipment for missionaries to carry out their evangelism around the globe.

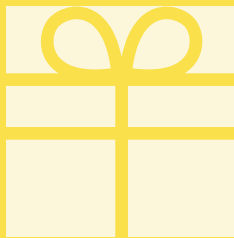
JUNGLE MISSIONARIES IN ECUADOR

WHEN PLANS CHANGE, COMPASSION LEADS



Within a week of Hurricane Melissa hitting the shores of Cuba, our GO team of 13 landed in Camaguya, Cuba. Our initial plan was to help with construction work around a large church in Guaimarro. Soon after meeting with our Assemblies of God missionaries and Kingdom Builders partners, Brad and Shelly Foltz, as well as local Pastor Angel Martinez, we realized our mission was going to take a different path. Many churches, pastors, and church members were greatly impacted by the winds of the hurricane as well as inland flooding.

Immediate need for food and basic living supplies was greatly needed. Instead of investing our Kingdom Builders funds in a construction project, we felt God leading us to reach out and help those affected by the storm. While in the country, the team traveled to areas hit hard by the hurricane in southeastern Cuba. Carrying with us large bags of rice, sugar, beans, canned goods, frozen chicken, water purifiers, soap, hygiene goods, and anything else that you can imagine to give to many of those who lost everything. We met with groups consisting of 5, 10, or 20 pastors of local Assemblies of God churches that were affected by the storm. Supplies were portioned out to the pastors,

and they would distribute supplies to those in the greatest need. There had been no electricity in these areas for 10 days. Food, clean water, and building supplies are very difficult to get in Cuba as their economy is in a deep recession. In 2019, on our last visit, the US dollar was \$1 to \$20 Cuban pesos; it is now \$1 to \$450 pesos. We are so honored to be able to extend the compassion and generosity of Jesus to the people of Cuba.

It was an unforgettable experience for our team consisting of 9 first-time GO participants as well as 4 seasoned members. We prayed, cried, and laughed with our new Cuban friends. The faith, perseverance, and unwavering joy that the Cuban people displayed, even in some of their darkest days, showed through brightly at every meeting. The prayers of the Cuban people were those of help, and our team felt so blessed to be used by God for exactly that moment in their lives. Please continue to pray for our Cuban brothers and sisters and their struggles in their daily living, and that God continues to move in their country.

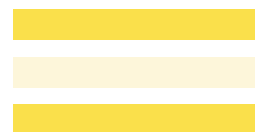

For many families in the Arab world, following Jesus comes at a cost. Hardship, displacement, and social isolation often become part of their story. Yet in the middle of that struggle, God continues to write moments of joy that remind people they are seen and loved.

This fall, the Abrahamsons shared one of those moments. They serve among Syrian families who are navigating new life and new faith far from home. One such family is led by a man named Fawzi, who was baptized last year. Since then, he and his wife have faced heavy challenges that could have crushed their hope if not for the grace of God breaking in at just the right time.

One afternoon, they felt a sudden nudge to change their plans and invite Fawzi's family on a picnic. They loaded up games, food, and supplies and headed into a nearby forest for a simple day outside. As they drove home, Fawzi asked, "What made you think to take us out for a picnic today?" When they shared how they sensed God leading her to reach out, his face lit up.

Just a week before, he and his wife were walking and he confessed how much he longed for the smell and taste of grilled meat under the trees, but had no idea when that day might come again. When the invitation arrived, they knew God had answered a quiet, heartfelt prayer. Their children spent the day laughing, playing frisbee and bocce ball for the first time, and went home shouting, "This was the best day we've ever had!"

Moments like that may seem ordinary. A grill. A forest. A family afternoon. But for a family rebuilding trust, community, and belonging, it becomes a holy reminder: God cares about the details of their lives. He is present in their loneliness. He brings joy where sorrow once lived.

This is the impact of Kingdom Builders. Your generosity creates space for missionaries like the Abrahamsons to not only share the Gospel but to embody it: serving, noticing, cheering on new believers, and helping them experience the delight of God through simple friendship.

The Abrahamsons ask us to continue praying for peace in their region, perseverance for their team, and deepening faith among new disciples. And as they enter their oldest son's final year at home and invite more workers to join them through their 2026 internship, they remain incredibly grateful for New Life Church's prayers and support.

Every time you give, every time you pray, you help answer someone's longing that God already hears. Together, we are bringing the hope of Jesus to families who have been waiting for a reminder that He sees them.

CHURCH BOOM

Ten thousand churches in the U.S. close each year, which means almost 200 churches close every Sunday. Church Boom's mission is to make a difference by offering financial assistance, free ministry leadership conferences, coaching and much more to struggling and declining churches nationwide.

CHURCH BOOM TESTIMONY

After Hurricane Milton tore through Trilby, Florida, New Life Church was left damaged and discouraged. For a moment, it looked like the storm might have the final word. But then you stepped in.

Because of your giving, what was nearly lost has now been fully restored.

The sanctuary has been rebuilt. The walls once soaked by the storm now echo with worship again. What could have been the end of a church family became a powerful testimony of what God can do when His people come together.

Because of our partnership with Church Boom, churches like this receive:

COLLAGE

Collage in Kearney, Grand Island, and Columbus is a Christ-centered place of hope and restoration for those facing the reality of an STD, an unexpected pregnancy, or even a struggle with a past pregnancy decision.

COMPASS

Compass is a faith-based organization that walks alongside children and families in central and southwestern Nebraska with foster care services, parenting supervision and training, intensive family preservation, counseling services and local CarePortal ministries to meet practical family needs.

DEBORAH'S LEGACY

Deborah's Legacy is a Christ-centered restoration program for women healing from addiction, homelessness and crisis living. The program is located in North Platte and provides both residential and non-residential support. Rent-free housing, meals, classes, prayer support and workforce development are all made available as means of providing hope and healing.

Melissa and Nathan Elstermeier have a heart for children who have endured more than most could imagine. As directors of Royal Family KIDS Kearney, they lead a ministry dedicated to creating life-changing moments for children in the foster care system who have experienced emotional and relational trauma.

For the Elstermeiers, the mission is simple: to share the love and hope of Christ through meaningful relationships. Each summer, Royal Family KIDS hosts a weeklong camp filled with laughter, worship and belonging. Every child receives a Bible, hears about Jesus and is reminded that they are loved and chosen. After camp, many of those same children join the ministry's year-round mentoring program, where the seeds of faith continue to grow.

Melissa recalled two siblings, Lacy and Jett, whose stories show how God is at work through RFK.

"Lacy and Jett are placed in a Christian foster home and were raised in an atheist home," Melissa said. "After camp, Jett proudly wore his camp shirt that read, 'God has big plans for me,' to a visit with his family. They made him change his shirt before he could go inside. More recently, Lacy was excited to let her foster mom know she has been allowed to take her Bible into her room during her visits. It is encouraging to see how God is working and the family is softening their hearts for the new faith the children are sharing."

Melissa first got involved with Royal Family KIDS in 2017 after noticing a booth at New Life Church, where she and Nathan are members.

"I didn't know anything about the foster care system, but jumped at the opportunity to volunteer at a camp for a week," Melissa said.

That first experience was life-changing.

"My first summer volunteering at RFK, I was shocked to see over 80 children from our local communities get off a bus and know they had all experienced abuse, neglect and abandonment,"

Melissa said. "I quickly saw the positive impact that RFK had on the kids, and was even more impacted myself. God is doing incredible things through this ministry, and I want to continue to be part of it."

Through the support of New Life Church — the sponsoring church for Kearney's RFK chapter—the Elstermeiers have seen firsthand how God uses His people to bring healing and hope. Volunteers, church staff and Kingdom Builders funds all play a vital role in making the ministry possible.

This year's Kingdom Builders theme, "Believe for More," inspired by 2 Peter 3:9, reflects the heart of Royal Family KIDS.

"It can feel defeating to watch children and families suffer in this broken world," Melissa said.

"Through the hope of Christ, we can meet these families where they are, knowing we have a patient God that wants all to know and believe in Him."

For the Elstermeiers, "believing for more" means trusting that every moment of love, every story shared and every campfire song points one more child to Jesus.



LOCAL CHURCH MINISTRY TOOLS

As we continue to expand and update ministry at each of our campuses, the funding of new and updated ministry tools, such as sound and lighting equipment, is needed to maximize our impact.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

We want everyone in our local communities to be presented with the opportunity to hear the Gospel message. We will use a variety of local outreach efforts in the Kearney, North Platte, Holdrege, and Ogallala areas to introduce people to the love of Jesus and the community of believers at New Life.

TODD BECKER FOUNDATION

The Todd Becker Foundation was started following the death of 18 year-old Todd Becker, who was killed in an alcohol-related car accident in 2005. Since its inception, the foundation ministry has visited over 500 public high schools, reaching nearly 100,000 students with their message that challenges students to take the narrow road in their journey through life (Matthew 7:13).

CROSSROADS MISSION AVENUE

A Christ-centered local mission in Kearney that provides a four-phase program of recovery to homeless men, women and children. Crossroads provides free food, shelter and clothing to their guests while they are completing the program.

ROYAL FAMILY KIDS CAMP

A Christ-centered ministry for abused, abandoned and neglected children in the foster care system. We are sending ten kids from the Kearney area to camp for a week where they will experience the love of Jesus.

HOLDREGE FOOD PANTRY

Support for the food pantry helps meet a very practical need in the Holdrege area through providing food for those who need it.





JUBILEE CENTER

The Jubilee Center offers supportive services in the Kearney area for food, clothing, rent, utilities and medication assistance. Our financial and volunteer support assists the Jubilee Center in providing their clients the social, economic, financial and spiritual tools necessary to become active participants in the community.

LOCAL SERVANT PROJECTS

As a Kingdom Builder, you are helping to fund serving projects and meet local needs in Kearney, North Platte, Holdrege, and Ogallala.

WOMEN'S RESOURCE CENTER

A confidential, supportive program serving North Platte and the surrounding communities in Lincoln County assisting women and couples experiencing an unplanned pregnancy.

CHURCH MULTIPLICATION NETWORK

Church Multiplication Network of the Assemblies of God USA is striving to see a Spirit-empowered, healthy church in every community in the nation. Since its inception, CMN has aided in the training of more than 8,500 leaders and in facilitating the launch of more than 5,000 new Assemblies of God churches. CMN has also worked with the AGTrust to distribute more than \$22 million in matching funds.

NEW LIFE CITYCARE COUNSELING CENTER

At New Life CityCare Counseling Center, we provide professional Christian counseling and mental health therapy to individuals, couples, and families.

Fire Bibles are sent to hundreds of prisoners and chaplains every year throughout the United States. As a Kingdom Builder, you are bringing the light of God's Word into dark places.

Through our partner, Fire Bibles for Inmates, hundreds of prisoners and chaplains receive God's Word every year. Your giving helps bring light to dark places and hope to those who need it most.

Here's one powerful testimony:

"I've been a Christian all my life, but when I got locked up, I found I really didn't know anything [about God]. After doing Chaplain Hammy's Bible Study, he gave me the Fire Bible. I really know now that God loves me... no matter what I've done in my past. I've turned from my sins and have asked Jesus to come into my life. It makes me happy to know how much [God] loves me... I love reading my Bible and I pray that you all will continue to support the Kansas Prison system with the Fire Bible. Thank you for opening my eyes."

VOCATIONAL MINISTRY COLLEGE FRESHMEN

We have a passion to equip, empower and train the next generation to fill ministry roles. We are providing grants to college freshmen who are pursuing vocational ministry degrees.

Brady Cone has turned his personal journey of faith into a mission to guide others toward hope, freedom and truth. As a missionary partner with New Life Church, Cone has spent more than a decade helping families and churches navigate complex issues of sexuality and gender, while pointing people to Christ.

Brady's story begins nearly 20 years ago in Nebraska, where he struggled with questions about his identity. He initially sought acceptance in the LGBTQ community, believing it was the only way to live authentically. But God placed people in his life who displayed love and the Gospel in tangible ways, softening his heart toward Christianity.

"They loved me and displayed the Gospel to me and shared the Gospel with me, and I came to know Christ," he said. "I walked away from homosexuality... and started this discipleship journey of God untwisting what my heart had twisted and giving me more and more freedom."

After college, Brady worked in college ministry, witnessing firsthand how God transforms the lives of young adults grappling with truth, identity and purpose. As his story became known, pastors sought his guidance on ministering to families and congregants facing similar struggles. What began as casual counsel evolved into a full-time calling: Calibrate Ministries.

"We named it Calibrate because that means to set something to a standard," Brady said. "I'd seen over and over again that I need to go back to God's Word and kind of reset my sexuality, my desires, my feelings, my life. It needs to be set to God's standard, and that is His word."

Calibrate Ministries operates through live speaking engagements, a podcast addressing faith and culture, and a parents' ministry that supports families whose children are navigating LGBTQ issues. Brady emphasizes equipping parents to first experience God's grace, so they can walk alongside their children in love.

"Many of the parents join the parents' ministry with the mindset, 'How can we fix my child?'" he said. "The heart of the parents' ministry is that we apply the Gospel to the parents' life and help them experience God's grace and hope, so that they can walk alongside their child with love."

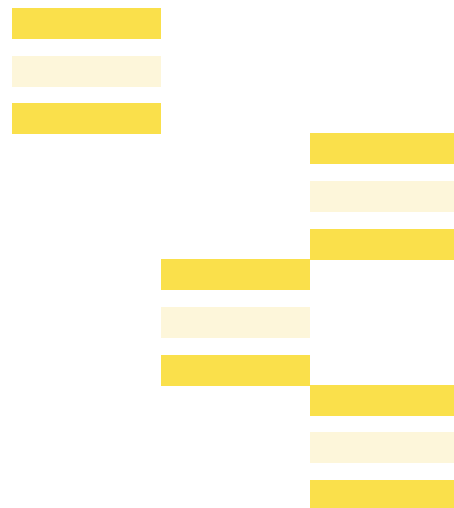
Cone's approach combines empathy, deep listening and careful guidance. He encourages individuals to engage with their local church, fostering discipleship and community where real transformation can occur.

Reflecting on 2 Peter 3:9, which says, "The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead, he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance," Cone sees a clear mandate for his ministry.

"I want everyone to understand that God has a heart for everyone... His grace is sufficient,"

"We need to be a part of that. It's not too late for anyone, and God can use us as part of the process."

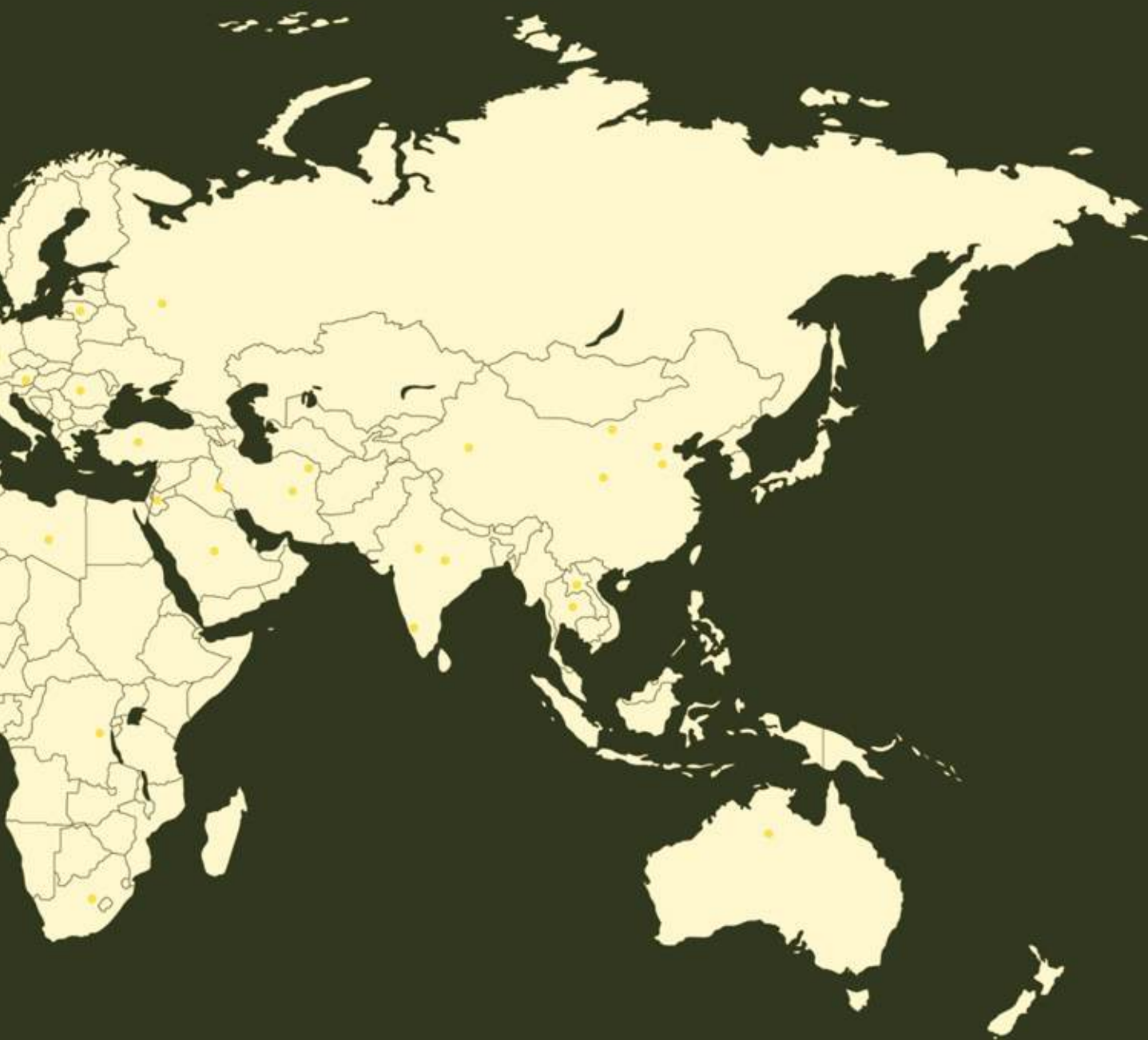
